14	1. A new plan for the construction and estimated cost for relocating outside of the City of Staunton,
15	to be implemented should the referendum pass, and a plan with estimated costs for the renovation and
16 17	expansion of the courthouse in the City of Staunton, to be implemented should the referendum fail, are
18	developed; 2. Both plans are to be made available to the public at least three months prior to the planned date
19	of the referendum; and
