6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 46.2-803.2, relating to trucks;
7	operation in certain weather conditions.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-803.2 as follows:
10	§ 46.2-803.2. Operation of heavy trucks in certain weather conditions.
11	A. When driving a truck or truck and trailer or semitrailer combination with a gross weight rating
12	greater than 26,000 pounds during active snow, sleet, or freezing rain, the operator:
13	1. Shall, if reasonably possible and conditions safely permit, drive the vehicle in the right-most lane
14	of any highway having two or more lanes in each direction;
15	2. Shall not utilize cruise control; and
16	3. Shall not utilize compression release engine brakes.
17	B. This section shall not apply to the operation of pickup trucks or panel trucks.
18	C. No law-enforcement officer shall stop a motor vehicle for a violation of subdivision A 2 or 3. No
