3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Exhaust systems; excessive noise.

5. Summary: Removes provisions that prohibit a law enforcement officer from (i) stopping a motorcycle, moped, motorized skateboard, or scooter for a noise violation, (ii) stopping a motor vehicle for not having an exhaust system in good working order, and stopping a motor vehicle for violating a local ordinance relating to the ownership or maintenance of a motor vehicle such the offense is jailable. The bill also removes provisions providing that for each type of offense, no evidence discovered or obtained as a result of such a stop shall be admissible in court.
