4. Title: Health insurance; health care provider panels; termination of provider.

5. Summary: The bill directs the Bureau of Insurance to convene a work group regarding continuity of care to determine options covered by insurance during the time that providers and insurance carriers are negotiating provider contracts. The work group shall provide recommendations to ensure proper notice to enrollees and providers, to ensure reasonable opportunities for continuity of care and coverage, and to determine whether special considerations should apply for health care systems that own and operate affiliated hospitals, medical groups, and insurance carriers.
