3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Department of Environmental Quality; issuance of issue certain permits.

5. Summary: Authorizes the Department of Environmental Quality to issue Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination Permits to certain existing sewage treatment plants that serve no more than 22 homes.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). DEQ states this bill is anticipated to impact the Town of Occoquan. HB30/SB30 as introduced includes \$325,000 the first year from the general fund for the Town of Occoquan to complete outfall sediment projects and for stormwater dredging activities.
