**2. Patron:** McDougle

**3. Committee:** Passed both Houses.

**4. Title:** Department of Health; triennial audit requirement for home care organizations.

**5. Summary:** Directs the Department of Health to remove the triennial audit requirement for home care organizations.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Minimal, see item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The provisions of this bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Virginia Department of Health (VDH). The triennial audit is performed by an outside source and not by VDH. Any fiscal impact to amend regulations can be handled within existing resources.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** None.

**10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** No.

**11. Other Comments:** VDH can absorb the cost to promulgate regulations for the provisions of a single bill with existing resources. However, if a large number of bills become law with a requirement that VDH promulgate or modify regulations, then VDH indicates it will need additional resources to handle the increase in workload.
